

ANNUAL ORGANIZATION MEETING

VILLAGE OF PALMYRA, N.Y.                   APRIL 5, 1971                   8:00 P.M.

The clerk-treasurer advised that the oath of office had been administered to the elected Mayor, David M. Nussbaumer, for a term of two years elected Trustees Lloyd A. Green and Frederick Alderman.

Mayor Nussbaumer announced that appointments should be made for the ensuing period, and that wages, hours and salaries be set, with provision for holidays and other stipulations regarding employment conditions, and benefits.

MAYOR AND TRUSTEES: The salary of Mayor has been set at \$1,000.00

per annum for a two year term beginning April 1, 1971 with payment bi-annually September 30th and March 31st in the amount of \$500.00 bi-annually. The salary of the trustees so elected as of April 1, 1971 shall receive a salary of \$625.00 per annum with payment bi-annually in the amount of \$312.50 as of September 30th and March 31st for a period of two years. The salaries of the trustees so elected as of April 1, 1970 shall continue in the amount of \$625.00 per annum with payment bi-annually in the amount of \$312.50 payable September 30th and March 31st for the ensuing year.
