"Ayes," Mayor & Trustees **MINUTES** Vrubel & Elliott - Trustee Rolland "abstained", having been absent from said mtg. Carried. Trustee Vrubel motioned acceptance of Minutes of 3/19/85 Spec. Bd. Mtg.; Trustee Elliott seconded. All "ayes," carried. The Bd. met on 3/25/85 for a "Budget Worksession"; Trustee Elliott motioned acceptance of recording of meeting; Trustee Vrubel seconded. All "ayes," Carried.

ZBA/PLANN. Trustee Elliott spoke of reg. Plann. Bd. mtg. on 4/3/85; and two ZBA Hrngs on 4/9/85 - A.D.P. Publications - variance to place automobile dealership at 505 W. Main St., and a variance requested **BRDS** by Beer/Pollack to build mutiple dwellings on W. Foster St.

W&WW Mr. Elliott said that he toured sewer plant recently with Supt. H. Kruger and Engineer Dan Means - Eng. to make recommendations. W&WW employee, Forrest Huff, completed W&WW Operator's School -Mr. Huff's 26-wk. prob. period up and upon recommendation of Mr. Kruger, Trustee Elliott moved that Mr. HUff's appointment be made permanent.
