*Note from Clerk-Treasurer: The high dollar amount of this abstract was due mostly to the annual payment to Wayne County Water and Sewer for our payment towards the WWTP. This year's payment was \$588,303.64. In addition, we paid for WCWSA service contract (\$22,000), school tax bills for the water line (\$7,000), Town and Village payment towards the Community Center (\$25,000) and Servpro for the mold remediation at the Fire Hall (\$27,000).
