ARTICLE I

Lights

[Adopted 5-4-1992 by L.L. No. 1-1992; amended in its entirety 12-6-2004 by L.L. No. 2-2004]

§ 155-1. Amber light required on all snowplowing vehicles.

Any person operating a motor vehicle and engaging in the plowing of snow for hire shall have affixed to his or her vehicle a working amber light visible to all approaching traffic under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of 500 feet from such vehicle.

§ 155-2. Penalties for offenses.

Any person not observing the provisions of § 155-1 hereof shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$250 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or both, for each violation.
