I. POLICY

A. It is the policy of the Palmyra Police Department to make crime prevention a cooperative effort between the members of the Department and the residents, business owners and visitors of the community.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. All members of the Department are responsible for identifying community needs for selected crime prevention programs.
- B. Upon identifying a specific crime problem within the community, the officer will notify the Chief of Police of the specific problem, along with any suggestions for solution or resolution.
- C. Officers will be proactive in crime prevention. They will be alert to security issues at locations in the Village and will make crime prevention suggestions to citizens.
 - 1. Officers will suggest citizens lock their homes and vehicles
 - 2. Officers will suggest security lighting be maintained.
 - 3. Officers will report street lights not working, inoperative lights at commercial and Village maintained locations (ie: retail stores and parks). These reports can be in the form of an e mail memo to the Chief of Police for follow up.
