**WATER CONTINGENCY TRANSFER: LEAD AND COPPER STUDY:** Motion was made by Trustee Perry, second by Trustee Nolan to transfer \$9,300.00 from F1990.4 Water Contingency to the Capital Project for the Lead and Copper Study. Vote, 3 ayes. CARRIED.

**RESOLUTION: MATCHING GRANT EPF GRANT:** Motion was made by Trustee Nolan, second by Trustee Perry to adopt the following resolution with regards to H88 WWTP Engineering Planning Study:

### AUTHORIZATION AND APPROPRIATION OF 20% LOCAL MATCH

Whereas, the Village of Palmyra has applied for and subsequently received notice of award of an engineering planning grant, and,

Whereas, implementation of the planning grant will enable the Village of Palmyra to collect information about the condition and needs of the Village's wastewater treatment and sanitary sewer system, and,

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Whereas, the Village of Palmyra must provide a minimum local match of \$7,500 to enjoy benefit of the maximum grant award of \$30,000 from the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT:

RESOLVED that the Village of Palmyra authorizes and appropriates a minimum of 20% local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program for the wastewater engineering planning project. Under the Engineering Planning Grant Program, this local match must be at least 20% of the total project cost. The maximum local share appropriated subject to any changes agreed to by the Village of Palmyra shall not exceed \$7500 based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of \$37,500. The Village of Palmyra may increase this local match through the use of in kind services without further approval from the Village of Palmyra.

Vote, 3 ayes. CARRIED.

**BANK PARKING LOT:** The new owner of the bank building next door has requested that we provide him with an Indemnification agreement like we provided Community Bank. The Clerk will forward a copy of same to Atty. Williams.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Motion was made and seconded to enter executive session for discussion of a purchase offer. Vote, 3 ayes. CARRIED.

**<u>PUBLIC SESSION:</u>** Motion was made and seconded to re-enter public session at 8:00 p.m. with no action having taken place. Vote, 3 ayes. CARRIED.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Motion made and seconded to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. Vote, 3 ayes. CARRIED.
