

Palmyra Historic Preservation Commission
November 21, 2019
Meeting Minutes

Present: J. Elliott, C. Daly, E. Drake, M. Haskins, J. Robbins

Meeting was called to order at 7:19 pm.

Motion to approve July minutes was made by J. Elliot, seconded by J. Robbins, and approved unanimously.

The co-chairs for 2020 of the Commission will be J. Elliott and C. Daly.

Discussion 1: proposal of possible future local landmarks was discussed. J. Robbins will draft a letter to some owners of possible landmarks for discussion at the January 2020 meeting. This letter will also be the basis of a newspaper article. The PHPC will invite prospective owners to a meeting. Information on tax credits, state and national grants will be researched by E. Drake. The February 20 meeting was proposed as an informational meeting on this topic

Discussion 2: possible topic for meetings through August were discussed. January – input and presentation discussion for February meeting; February meeting – see above; March – part II of February meeting to discuss the how and why of local designation; April – spotlight month, discussion of inventory of designated homes; May – Preservation month, prepare articles for Wayne times, Finger Lakes Times; June – J. Elliott to find out if someone from Zion Episcopal could do a presentation; July – J. Elliott to ask (? Dick Green) if someone from LDS could do a retrospective on the Hill Cumorah pageant; August – no meeting.

Discussion 3: misc. discussions. (1) E. Drake will ask the town clerk if the historian will be replaced; (2) E. Drake will ask the village clerk who is the current owner of the Griffith House and how to get in touch with that person; someone will find out the person to contact about a possible Garlock House presentation; C. Daly will complete the annual CLG report.
