<u>CHIEF YATES:</u> Supt. Ike met with Macedon Police Dept., Wayne County Sheriff and Palmyra Police Dept. to tell them about the Bullet Aid grant for \$30,000 that the district was just awarded. It will be divided at \$10,000 per department to cover salaries for sporting and special events. <u>PCC LEASE:</u> Motion was made by Trustee Husk second by Trustee Perry to authorize the Mayor to sign the ninety nine year lease with the Palmyra Community Center as submitted and reviewed. Vote 4 ayes. CARRIED.
